



Red Wine

- 1 **Hazy View Pinotage 2007/08 (South Africa)**
Medium bodied with ripe, brambly fruit through to a lively finish. Very drinkable style.
- 2 **Paula Cabernet Mendoza 2008 (Argentina)**
Ripe, red fruit can be found along with the complexity provided by mint notes and cassis.
- 3 **Don David Reserve Malbec 2007/08 (Argentina)**
Concentrated aromas of red fruit, spices and toasted notes from the oak. Rich and complex flavour with a very long and attractive aftertaste.
- 4 **Echeverria Carmenere 2007/08 (Chile)**
Dark chocolate with sweet fruit on the attack and lovely extract with balanced tannins.
- 5 **Ninquen Cabernet Sauvignon, Vina Mont Gras 2005 (Chile)**
Deep, complex rich flavours, with layers of black cherries, ripe currants and firm tannins, which give this wine structure muscles and a long finish.
- 6 **Côtes du Rhône 'Les Vignes du Prince' 2007 - (France)**
Spicy berryed fruit with typical warm and savoury flavours from the South of France. Fruity, soft and easy drinking in style.
- 7 **The Black Shiraz 2008 (Australia)**
An espresso of a wine! Strong, purple black and intense.
- 8 **Le Beau Chêne Pinot Noir d'Oc 2007/08 (France)**
Fresh primary red berry fruit style with a rounded, mellow flavour.
- 9 **Head over Heels Merlot 2008 (Australia)**
This Merlot is a wine of restrained power with an intense, ripe berry bouquet with hints of chocolate and liquorice.
- 10 **Agustinos Merlot Mourvedre Reserva Maipo 2007/08 (Chile)**
A deep dark blackberry-scented wine which is full-bodied with a long spicy finish.
- 11 **Chianti Classico 'San Jacopo' DOCG 2007 (Italy)**
Ripe and fruity wine with black cherry flavours and a soft touch of tannins. Full of fruit with a hint of spice.
- 12 **Ondarre Reserva Rioja 2002/04 (Spain)**
Traditionally styled Rioja, smooth, ripe and subtle with the added complexity of vanilla and well integrated tannins in a long finish.

Rosé Wine

- 13 **Saint Clair Pinot Noir Rosé 2008 (New Zealand)**
A fresh and appealing wine with flavours of cherry and redcurrant, underlying strawberries and cream tones.
- 14 **Anjou Rosé Domaine des Cedres 2007/08 (France)**
Round and fruity. It is a medium dry wine, which can be served with exotic spicy dishes.

Port

- 15 **Barros LBV 2005 (Portugal)**
Deep colour with aromas reminiscent of ripe berry fruits and mulberry.

Champagne

- 16 **Moutard Prestige Rosé NV (France)** £35.50
Delicate salmon pink colour from short maceration on the skins and a well sustained, elegant and fresh, fruity flavour.
- 17 **Marc Hebrart Cuvée de Réserve 1er Cru NV (France)** £38.50
Mature biscuity nose, full clean palate with hints of red apple and an impressively long finish. Each bottle is then hand remuaged. Once blended the cuvée is bottled and left to mature for an impressive three and a half years..

White Wine

Bottle

- 18 **Pouilly Fuissé Domaine Ferrand 2007 (France)** £29.50
Characteristic flinty nose and palate opening out to show floral and dried fruit scents. Good weight, full bodied with balanced acidity through to a dry and citrus zesty finish.
- 19 **Groot Constantia Sauvignon Blanc 2007/08 (South Africa)** £23.95
A full bodied wine, showing typical character of Sauvignon Blanc, grown in a cool climate area like Constantia valley. Distinct ripe fig and gooseberry flavours, with green pepper and grassy tones. An elegant wine with a fresh and complex finish.
- 20 **Mendoza Heights Premium Chenin Blanc 2008/09 (Argentina)** £15.50
Lovely aromas of peach, mango and pineapple combined with mineral notes and mandarin, vanilla and honey on the palate. Fresh, fruit salad finish.
- 21 **Foundstone Unoaked Chardonnay 2008/09 (Australia)** £15.95
Zingy acidity underpins the flavours and keeps them lingering on the palate.
- 22 **Dopff au Moulin Gewurztraminer Grand Cru Brand de Turckheim 2005 (France)** £34.95
Lush, round and typically spicy, with a pungent fragrance, it shows the variety's finest attributes in the virile yet elegantly balanced DOPFF style.
- 23 **Dopff au Moulin Riesling 2008 (France)** £24.95
Discreetly fruity nose with a touch of minerals Crisp, bone dry, lively on the palate and so refreshing!
- 24 **Saint Clair Sauvignon Blanc 2008/09 (New Zealand)** £24.50
A full and crisp, powerful wine with intense aromas and flavours of passion fruit, blackcurrant, underlying gooseberry and herbal tones. Mouth-watering acidity is balanced by a full yet elegant palate that leads to a long lingering finish
- 25 **"Feudi d'Albe' Trebbiano d'Abruzzo DOC 2008 (Italy)** £17.95
The crispness of the Trebbiano is balanced by a small addition of Chardonnay to give weight. A clean and crisp wine with delicate citrus and peach flavours.

Dessert Wine

- 26 **Groot Constantia Grand Constance Muscat HALVES 2006 (South Africa)** 375ml £29.95
Typical Muscat characteristics are enhanced by nuances of walnuts, baked raisins and honey. A superb and richly flavoured dessert wine.
- 27 **Tamaya Sweet Goat 2006 (Chile)** 375ml £12.95
With a balanced, lively acidity, it displays a marvelous floral finish seasoned with candied and dried fruit that envelop its structure. Delicious.
